

**Internationale Deutsche Meisterschaft 2021
in the Windsurf class „Speed“
from August 21 to August 28, 2020
(The alternative day is August 29, 2020)**

Tender (Notice of Race)

Preamble:

The International German Championship in the windsurfing class "Speed" (International Speed Windsurfing Class) will be held as a one-week event in the 2021 season.

The International German Championship in speed windsurfing is sanctioned by the German Sailing Association (hereinafter DSV) and is organized and hosted by the Association of German Speedsurfer -VDS- e.V. (hereinafter VDS).

The participants also receive points for the official annual ranking in the windsurfing class "Speed" (factor 1.4). Guests receive points for a separate annual ranking.

IMPORTANT! It is expressly pointed out that the regatta is carried out under the currently valid Corona Control Ordinance of the state government of Schleswig-Holstein. The complete regulation can be found [here](#).

In particular, attention is drawn to maintaining a minimum distance of 1.5 meters from other people (distance requirement) and compliance with hygiene rules. More information can be found [here](#).

We ask for your active help and for your understanding if the processes are not as quick and pleasant as usual due to the hygiene measures.

1. Rules

The regatta is an event sanctioned by VDS, DSV and ISWC, where the following rules apply:

1. The VDS regulations 2020-2021
2. The racing rules sailing 2021 - 2024 (ISAF Racing Rules / RRS)
3. The ISWC Championship Rulebook 2010
4. The regulations for special sailing disciplines
5. The Notice of Race (announcement) and Sailing Instructions (sailing instruction)

Deviations from the NoR and the SI can only be made by the racing committee. The sailing instructions can change other racing rules. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text applies, and the German text for the DSV regulations.

2. Advertising and Event-Lycras

Advertising by the participant is limited as follows: Installation below the boom. Windsurfers can be obliged to put up advertising chosen and provided by the organizer.

The participants are obliged to wear the Event-Lycras over their surf clothing every time they ride on the water, whether for training or during the races.

3. Eligibility and registration

The regatta is open to participants in the speed surf class who are qualified according to SMO 8. The windsurfer must have a valid surf license that is required for the area in which they are sailing. For members of other national associations, a corresponding certificate of competence from their country applies. Every windsurfer must be a member of his national class association, e.g. the DWSV (German Windsurfing Association) or the GWA (German Windsurfing Association e.V.), as well as in its national association e.g. be a member of the DSV (German Sailing Association) (e.g. the VDS).

If a participant is not a member of an association membership, he can acquire one as part of the enrollment for € 40 per year (DWSV association membership).

Every participant belonging to a German association must have registered on the website of the German Sailing Association <https://www.dsv.org/regattasegler-registrierung/>.

The registration of eligible windsurfers must be made using the online registration form on the official website www.speedwindsurfen.de. **The registration deadline is Wednesday, June 30, 2021.**

Later registrations will be charged with a late registration fee of 50%. **Registrations on site are not possible.**

The following restrictions apply to the number of windsurfers: A maximum of 70 participants are permitted.

4. Entry fee

The registration fee is EUR 95 for the event. Children and young people under the age of 18 are exempt from the registration fee. If several people of a family are members of the VDS in a family, the second and each additional member pay half of the registration fee (from 24 years of age) or are exempt from the registration fee (up to and including 23 years of age). Club members from the age of 24 who are not qualified, however, also pay the full registration fee as the second or further person in a family.

The payment of the registration fee must be made with the registration. The entitlement to payment of the entry fee does not lapse if the entry is withdrawn or if the windsurfer fails to

attend. The entry fee will only be refunded if the entry is rejected. The fees are to be transferred to:

Direct debit is possible (see registration form) if the VDS has a SEPA direct debit mandate. If there is no SEPA direct debit mandate yet, the form can be downloaded from <http://www.speedwindsurfen.de/vds-mitglied-werden/>, filled out in full and signed to the office or the treasurer Heiner Biethan by Wednesday, 30. Encrypt June 2021 by post or for data protection reasons and send the key separately by e-mail to vds@speedwindsurfen.de.

ATTENTION! Cash payments on site are not possible.

5. Schedule

5.1. Event schedule (provisional):

- 5.1.1. Friday, August 20: arrival, rigging, free practice
- 5.1.2. Saturday, August 21: registration (9 a.m. to 11 a.m.), skippers meeting (11 a.m.), com-petitions (first possible start at 12:15 p.m.)
- 5.1.3. Sunday, August 22nd to Friday, August 27th: Skippers Meeting (possible from 7:00 a.m.), competitions (first possible start 8:00 a.m.)
- 5.1.4. Saturday, August 28th: 11:00 a.m. last possible start,
- 5.1.5. Saturday, August 28th: approx. 3 p.m. Award ceremony (participation required), departure
- 5.1.6. **If no valid rating has been entered by August 28th, Sunday, August 29th, will be used as the official regatta day. In this case, the provisions of point 5.1.3 apply to Saturday, August 28th, and the provisions of points 5.1.4 and 5.1.5 apply to Sunday, August 29th.**

5.2. The program can be changed by the organizing committee. A change in the time for the skippers meeting and / or the first possible start will be published on the notice board in good time. Otherwise the times of this program apply. The times for the skippers meeting and the first possible start on the first day of the event cannot be brought forward.

6. Sailing instructions

The sailing instructions will be given on August 21, 2021 during registration.

7. Venue

The venue is in Orth on Fehmarn. In the official event room / regatta office (club and event tent at the paddock on the meadow parking lot in Orth) there are maps showing the event area and a representation of the competition area along with a rough representation of the competition area in the east bay.

8. The lanes, competition area

The courses are set on site by the regatta management depending on wind and water conditions and announced at the respective skippers meeting. All participants start together - there is only one fleet.

9. Penalty system, jury and protest committee

- 9.1. Rule 44.1 does not apply! Self-punishment is therefore not possible. On the other hand, the race management can issue a warning. If you have two warnings, you may be excluded from the race. The decisions of the arbitral tribunal are final, as provided in rule 70.5.
- 9.2. An independent protest committee will negotiate the protests.

10. Doping Controls

- 10.1. Doping controls can take place during the event.

11. Rating

- 11.1. There is no fixed number of races.
- 11.2. A scoring comes about as soon as there is a valid result in the discipline. For this, a race or an elimination must be completed.
- 11.3. The ISAF RRS B 8.3, Alternative Scoring System (with 0.7 points for first place) is used.
- 11.4. Ties are solved according to ISAF RRS B12, Speed Competition Scoring.

12. Awards / award ceremony

12.1. The prizes and titles awarded by the DSV are based on SMO 14.

12.2. The VDS honors the participants as follows:

12.2.1. Trophies:

Men (over 21) 1st - 3rd place;
Women (over 21) 1st - 3rd place;
Youngsters (U17) and (U21) each 1st - 3rd place;
Grandmaster (over 50) 1st - 3rd place;
Greatmaster (over 60) 1st - 3rd place;
Ultimate Master (70+) 1st - 3rd place;

12.2.2. Certificates:

Men (over 21) 1st - 10th place;
Women (over 21) 1st - 5th place;
all others depending on the number of participants.

12.3. The categories will only be honored if at least 3 participants are registered in the respective category.

12.4. Participation in the award ceremony is mandatory.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

The responsibility for the decision of a windsurfer to take part in a race or to continue it rests with him alone. The windsurfer is responsible for the suitability and correct nautical behavior as well as for the suitability and the roadworthy condition of the reported board. In cases of force majeure or due to official orders or for security reasons, the organizer is entitled to make changes to the implementation of the event or to cancel the event. In these cases, the organizer is not obliged to pay compensation to the participant. The organizer is liable, for whatever legal reason, for property damage and financial loss of any kind and its consequences that the participant incurs during or in connection with participation in the event through the behavior of the organizer, his representatives, vicarious agents or agents the violation of duties that are not main / or Essential contractual obligations (cardinal obligations) are limited to damage caused intentionally or through gross negligence. In the event of a breach of cardinal obligations, the liability of the organizer in cases of simple negligence is limited to foreseeable, typically occurring damage. Insofar as the organizer's liability for damages is excluded or limited, the participant also exempts the employees - workers and employees - representatives, vicarious agents, sponsors and people who provide, drive or assist with the use of towing, security or rescue vehicles from their personal liability for damages, as well as all other persons to whom an order has been placed in connection with the implementation of the event. The valid racing rules of the ISAF, the class regulations as well as the regulations of the announcement and sailing instructions are to be observed and are expressly recognized. " The law of the Federal Republic of Germany.

14. Insurance

All participating windsurfers must have a valid surf liability insurance with coverage of at least € 1,000,000 (better: € 3,000,000) per event or the equivalent thereof.

15. Camping / accommodation / meals

15.1. The organization provides a paddock for a limited number of vehicles (approx. 55 vehicles) (see travel information at <http://www.speedwindsurfen.de/reiseinfo/>). All participants can spend the night in their cars, buses, mobile homes and caravans (with and without electricity) for a fee. Only participants with the appropriate permits are allowed to camp and park in the paddock area. The places will be allocated in the order of the registrations.

Other accommodation options (see travel information at <http://www.speedwindsurfen.de/reiseinfo/>) are available in Orth (parking spaces, holiday apartments) and in Flügge, 5 km away (campsites). Here you have to take care of your own accommodation.

15.2. Usable showers and toilets are available in the port for all participants.

15.3. Coffee, drinks (water / isotonic drinks) and fruit will be provided for the participants.

15.4. The participants take care of their own food.

16. Official event website

Daily news, photos and results can be found on the official website www.speedwindsurfen.de and www.facebook.com/Speedwindsurfen/.

17. Media

By registering for the event, the participant authorizes unlimited, including commercial use, demonstration and reproduction of photos, sound recordings and video material created by him during the event. This includes modifications and passing on the exploitation rights to third parties. The personal exploitation rights of the participant or those of third parties are not restricted by this.

18. Data protection

The personal data collected in connection with the registration are saved and used by the association to send information about the event to the participants. If you cancel the event or after the event, the data can be deleted again on request.

By participating in the event, the participants agree that their full name, sail number, ranking points, speeds and, if applicable, sponsors will be published on the club's website as well as

in social media and mass media. This involves the publication of the list of participants and all ranking lists.

18.1. Individual right of objection

You have the right, for reasons that arise from your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of personal data relating to you, which is based on data processing in the public interest and data processing on the basis of a balancing of interests; this also applies to profiling based on this provision.

If you object, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate reasons for processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend Legal claims.
